






Fig.1 On-Region Characteristics




Fig.2 On-Resistance Variation with Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Fig.3 On-Resistance Variation with Temperature




Fig.4 Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature




Fig.5 Transfer Characteristics




Fig.6 Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature




Fig.7 Gate Charge Characteristics




Fig.8 Capacitance Characteristics




Fig.9 Maximum Safe Operating Area




Fig.10 Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature




Fig.11 Transient Thermal Response Curve





Fig.12 Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation
